1st grade. Basic library skills, library as a place to seek information, getting to know children's literature.

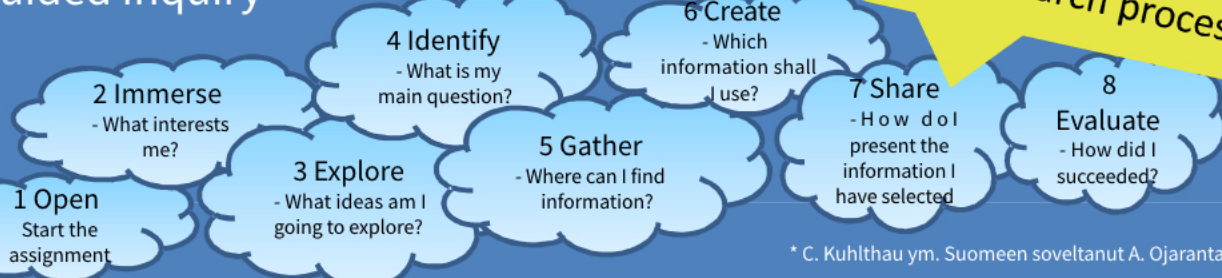
3rd grade. Finding the joy of reading. How to search books in the online catalogue.
